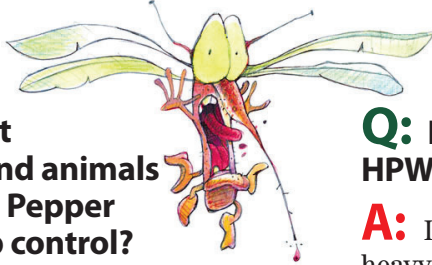




Just the **FAQs.**

Frequently asked questions about Hot Pepper Wax products.

Q: What insects and animals does Hot Pepper Wax help control?



A: For insects, HPW spray is especially good at controlling soft-bodied insects that feed on the leaves, flowers, fruit and stems of plants - insects like **aphids, spider mites, whiteflies, cabbage loopers, and beet armyworms.** Our animal repellent prevents garden raids by **squirrels and rabbits.**

Q: How do I apply it?

A: You should try to **spray every surface** of the plant. (Especially important is the underside of leaves, where garden pests try to hide when they sense danger!) After spraying your plants, leave them alone for about 12 hours. This gives time for the micro-thin sheet of liquefied wax to “set up” and harden. At it sets up, the wax loses its hazy white color and becomes transparent.



Q: When should it be applied?

A: Anytime, really, but for best effect, don't apply when it's rainy or windy, or when rain is in the immediate forecast.



Q: How frequently should HPW be applied?

A: If you're seeing heavy insect infestation, spray HPW Insect Repellent as often as every three days. Otherwise, every one or two weeks does it for maintenance. If rabbits and squirrels are using your garden as their salad bar, spray HPW Animal Repellent, spraying again if you see any nibbling. Spray new growth as it appears, then maintain repellency by spraying every one or two weeks.



Q: Is there a strong odor?



A: No; there's a **mild odor of pepper.** You may also get a hint of some of the herbs used in our product. (One of our customers termed HPW “pleasingly pungent!”)

Q: How safe is it, REALLY?

A: Safe enough to spray on vegetables in the morning and **pick and eat them the same day.** The ingredients in Hot Pepper Wax product can be found in your kitchen. We just put them together in a way that pests don't like.



Q: Where is it sold

Q: Hot Pepper Wax is EPA registered. What's that mean?

A: It means that **HPW proved to EPA regulators' satisfaction** that we can back up our claims. When we say our product works on certain insects and animals, and when we say it's safe to use on your plants we can back those claims with tests and studies.



Q: How is Hot Pepper Wax different from OTHER animal and insect repellents?

A: **First, it's the WAX.** The wax is our “**MOISTURE GUARD,**” an anti-transpirant. (Great for transplants, **great for Christmas greens** - it has a lot of uses!) The wax makes our product ‘stick’ to the plant, making it last longer. **Second, it's the PEPPER** mixed with the WAX.
